The Magento Special Offers extension improve the magento default Catalog Price Rules feature by listing the catalog price rules in frontend (as special offers page) and display each catalog price rule (offer view page) with additional fields like meta title, meta description, meta keywords, layout, design and etc.

So your site will be more attract to customer, which list all the special offers in one page and customer can also view details of that that offer. This will make customer come to your site more regularly to find out what's new special offers your site offer.

# a. System Requirements


- Support Magento Community Edition 1.5, 1.6, 1.7, 1.8, 1.9

### b. Installation

- Login to Magento Admin Panel
- Go to All4coding > Extension Manager
- Click the Install button of the extension and follow the instruction on the installation wizard to install the extension. Please Read All4coding Core Manual for more information.


# III. Configuration

## a. General




- **Title**: The title for the listing page.
- **Description**: The description for the listing page.
- **Title Separator**: This is used in offer view page. It will separate Configure Meta Title and Catalog Price Rule Meta Title.
- Meta Title: The meta title for the listing page for SEO.
- Meta Keywords: The meta keywords for the listing page for SEO.
- Meta Description: The meta description for the listing page for SEO.
- URL Key: SEF (Search Engine Friendly) link, use for SEO.
- Page Layout: page layout you want to set for the listing page.

# b. Custom Design



- Custom Design: The theme you want to set for the listing page.
- Active From: set a from time the custom design is applied. If empty the custom design will be applied immediately.
- Active To: set time that the custom design will expired. If empty the custom design will be applied forever.
- **Custom Layout**: the page layout you want to apply for the listing page.
- Custom Layout Update: The xml layout update you want to set for the listing page.

# c. Display




- Random Sort Offers: If set to yes the offers will be display randomly.
- **List Mode**: The display mode for products. You can set to "Use System Default" or you can set to "List" or "Grid".
- **Display Type**: You can set to "Show All Products" or "Show Only Number of Rows".
- **Display Rows**: This field is only visibled when "Display Type" is "Show Only Number of Rows". The number of rows each offer will display.

- **Show More Products**: This field is only visibled when "Display Type" is "Show Only Number of Rows". If set to "Yes" at the end of each offer a "Show More Products >>" link will be displayed.
- Random Sort Products: If set to "Yes" the products display in each offer will be displayed randomly.



# a. Description




You can add HTML to Catalog Price Rule Description. It will be display in offer view page in Front-end.

- Page Title: The meta title for this catalog price rule view page.
- **Meta Keywords**: The meta keywords for this catalog price rule view page.
- Meta Description: The meta description for this catalog price rule view page.


# c. Custom Design




- Custom Design: The theme you want to set for this offer view page.
- Active From: set a from time the custom design is applied. If empty the custom design will be applied immediately.
- Active To: set time that the custom design will expired. If empty the custom design will be applied forever.
- Page Layout: the page layout you want to apply for this offer view page.
- Custom Layout Update: The xml layout update you want to set for this offer view page.




# a. Widget Configuration



- Catalog Price Rule: Select the catalog price rule to display. If not selected, all catalog
  price rules will be displayed.
- Category: If select only offers that have products in the selected category will be display. If empty it will depend on the page context (If put the widget in the CMS page it will use the website root category, if put the widget in the category page it will use the category of that page). NOTE: If you have multi website be careful, only select the root category and sub category of the root category of that site. If you select a category not in the root category of the website you want the widget to display, then the widget products listing will be empty.
- Random Sort Offers: If set to yes the offers will be display randomly.
- **Show more Offers**: If set to "Yes" at the end of the widget a "Show More Offers" link will be displayed.

- Offer Count: The number of offers to show in the widget. If empty all catalog price rules will be shown.
- **Display Mode**: The display mode for products. You can set to "Use Default" (which will use the Special Offers Configuration), or you can set to "List" or "Grid".
- Random Sort Products: If set to "Yes" the products display in each offer will be displayed randomly.
- Number of Products to Display: The number of products to display in each offer.
- **Nubmer of Products in Row**: The number of product to display in each row in gird mode. If empty it will auto detect the number of product ot display in each row.
- **Show More Products**: If set to "Yes" at the end of each offer a "Show More Products >>" link will be displayed.
- Cache Lifetime: The number of second the widget cache will expire and refresh. If not set the default value is 86400, If set to 0 then the widget will not cache.
