I. INTRODUCTION

Sort Direction Extension allow you to set the default sort direction for all category and for a specific category.

II. INSTALLATION

a. System Requirements

- Support Magento Community Edition 1.4, 1.5, 1.6, 1.7, 1.8
- All4coding Core v2.0.0

b. Installation

- Login to Magento Admin Panel
- Go to **All4coding > Extension Manager**
- Click the Install button of the extension and follow the instruction on the installation wizard to install the extension. Please Read All4coding Core Manual for more information.

III. Settings

Go to **All4coding > Sort Direction Settings**


